Project Update

Evolugen is proposing **the 98 MW Sunrise Solar Project**, which will be located in the Municipal District (M.D.) of Pincher Creek, North-West of the town of Pincher Creek. The Project is sited on cultivated lands used for agriculture and are privately owned by one landowner.

Since sharing our last community newsletter in January 2023, we continue to advance the Project design and engineering, interconnection and permitting. We are pleased to share that Alberta Environment and Protected Areas – Fish and Wildlife Stewardship (AEP-FWS) reviewed the Project and determined that the risk to wildlife, habitat, breeding and key features for species and risk is low.
